We are pleased to announce a new eLearning course: **Cognitive Adaptation Training (CAT) eLearning Certification**. This training is provided by Money Follows the Person (MFP) grant funding from Texas Health and Human Services.

Cognitive Adaptation Training (CAT) eLearning Certification

This 18-module course is inclusive of the 6 module *Cognitive Adaptation Training: An Introduction** AND 12 modules intended as an alternative to the live instructor led 2-day CAT workshop. In total, these 18 modules meet the requirements to become a Certified CAT Practitioner.

This comprehensive course provides you with both a basic and advanced understanding of CAT treatment. The course presents an in-depth review of the CAT model, utilizing CAT assessments, treatment planning, implementing a wide range of advanced interventions, documentation in CAT services, utilizing Motivational Interviewing during CAT, and differences between CAT and other evidenced-based practices.
